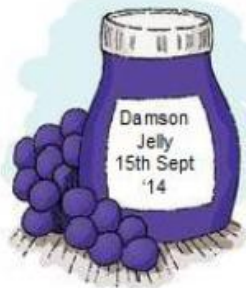


MULTIPLE ENTRIES PERMITTED FOR ALL CLASSES



Class 1 "THANKSGIVING PUMPKIN PIE"

Pumpkin pie baked in an open flan in a ring or dish size 20-25cm (8-10") and displayed on a plate. See p120 OWTS 2011/12

Class 2 "AFTER DINNER INDULGENCE"

5 chocolate truffles in sweet cases displayed on a plate or dish. All made from one mixture but may be decorated differently.

Class 3 "JELLY TREAT"

A jar of fruit jelly made from any fruit in a jar size approx 225g (8oz). See p132 OWTS 2011/12. No jars or lids with commercial names or marks.

Class 4 "CHILDRENS PARTY"

A decorated gingerbread house on a board. All decorations to be edible. Everything to be judged. Please state if any raw egg is used.

Class 5 "HALLOWEEN PARTY"

A carved pumpkin suitable to hold a tea light (do not include).

Class 6 "HAPPY BIRTHDAY"

A hand-made Birthday Card in any medium. Maximum size 23x15cm (9"x6") See p76 OWTS. No envelope required.

Class 7 "KNIT AND NATTER"

A hand knitted cosy for a teapot or cafetiere. You might like to include your own teapot or cafetiere for display. See p78 OWTS 2011/12.

Class 8 "CHRISTMAS MORNING"

A handmade Christmas stocking in fabric, not knitted or crocheted. Overall length 45 - 60cm (18"-24") with a loop for hanging.

Class 9 "STRICTLY PARTY"

An exhibit of natural plant material in a high-heeled shoe. To be displayed on a board. Space allowed 60cm x 60cm (24"x 24"), height unrestricted. Accessories allowed. See p153-4 OWTS 2011/12.

RULES

****ALL ENTRY FEES – Listed on Entry Form**** **SOUTH OF ENGLAND AUTUMN SHOW 2015**

1. **IT IS VERY IMPORTANT THAT ALL PARTICIPATING MEMBERS ARE GIVEN A COPY OF THE SCHEDULE AND RULES. NB: Schedule is also available to view on Federation web-sites**
2. The Schedule must be strictly adhered to, or the entry will be disqualified. **THE JUDGES' DECISION IS FINAL.**
3. Please refer to the NFWI "**On With the Show**" 2011/12 Edition 5 Handbook (OWTS 2011/12) for the definitions of the various classes (available on the Moodle)
4. All exhibitors must be WI Members.
5. Closing date for entries Friday 18th September 2015
6. **ALL WIs WHO ENTER MUST ENCLOSE TWO C5 23cm x 16cm (9"x 6½") STAMPED ADDRESSED ENVELOPES.**
7. WIs will be allocated a number in September and this number must be fastened to all items. Pre-Show Entry passes to the Showground for Judging Day will be forwarded as soon as they are available.
8. In the event that a WI has to cancel any of their entries they **MUST NOTIFY THE SHOW DESIGNER.**
It is regretted that Entry Fees cannot be refunded.
9. All Classes must be brought to the Showground on **Friday 2nd October 2015 and staged between 10.30am and 11.30am.** Allotted set-up time is 30 minutes. The Room will be closed at 11.30am. Packaging will not be returned. Entry will be via the North Gate and round to the Blue Gate. Members may park briefly outside.
10. **ONLY TWO MEMBERS PER WI** will be allowed into the Room to avoid congestion.
11. All items must be the property and unaided work of the Exhibitors. They must have been made within the last 12 months.
12. If you have **multiple entries for a class** they will be labelled with your WI number and a letter a, b etc. On a piece of paper please list the names of the entrants next to the letter identifying their work and put it into an **envelope marked with your WI number and class.**
13. No miniatures.
14. For **EACH CLASS** all WIs will be supplied with a jewellers' tag with their allocated number, which must be sewn, stuck or fixed (no pins) securely to all items. **Any items used as accessories must also be marked with their WI number**
15. Although the greatest care will be taken, the WI will not accept any responsibility for the loss or damage to property at any time.
16. **PLEASE DO NOT USE VALUABLE ITEMS.**
17. **REMOVAL - No exhibit or mark cards may be removed before dusk on Sunday 4th October 2015.** The Committee will not accept responsibility for any items not collected by 6.00pm.
18. **No packaging will be available.**
19. **No cars are admitted on to the Showground until after 5pm.**
20. Any queries regarding the Show Schedule must be addressed to the Autumn Show Designer for 2015.
