## ***MULTIPLE ENTRIES PERMITTED FOR ALL CLASSES***

### **Class 1 GET FRUITY**

A jar of jam made from any soft fruit in a jar size approx. 454g. Can be mixed fruit. See p129-132 OWTS 2015.

### **Class 2 LET'S PARTY**

5 decorated fairy/cupcakes for a child's party displayed on a plate or stand. All made from one mixture but may be decorated differently. See p107-109 OWTS 2015.

### **Class 3 ROLL UP ROLL UP**

5 sausage rolls (meat or vegetarian filling) displayed on a board or slate. See p121 OWTS 2015.

### **Class 4 A BOX OF DELIGHTS**

At least 5 pieces of homemade fudge, any variety but made from one mix. Displayed in an open box. See p124 OWTS 2015.

### **Class 5 DECK THE HALLS**

A hand-made wreath made of fabric, not paper. May be knitted or crocheted With hanging loop. Embellishments allowed. Any size.

### **Class 6 WEIGHT LIMIT**

A hand-knitted/crocheted item(s) made from NO MORE THAN A TOTAL of 100g yarn. More than one yarn may be used. Embellishments allowed.

### **Class 7 PIN INTEREST**

A pin cushion, any technique.

### **Class 8 CRAFTY GREETING**

A hand-crafted Christmas card. Size 23cm x 15cm maximum. No envelope required. See p76 OWTS 2015.

### **Class 9 TEA TIME SURPRISE**

An exhibit of natural plant material in a cup and saucer. Accessories allowed within the exhibit. See p 153 OWTS 2015.

## ***MULTIPLE ENTRIES PERMITTED FOR ALL CLASSES***

### **RULES**

- 1. It is important that all participating members are given a copy of the schedule and rules. These are available on the Federation web-sites.**
- 2. The Schedule must be strictly adhered to, or the entry will be disqualified. THE JUDGES' DECISION IS FINAL.**
- 3. Please refer to NFWI "On With the Show" 2015 Edition 6 Handbook (OWTS 2015) for the definitions of the various classes (available on the Moodle)**
- 4. All exhibitors must be WI Members.**
- 5. Closing date for entries Friday 15<sup>th</sup> September 2017**
- 6. ALL WIs WHO ENTER MUST ENCLOSE ONE C5 23cm x 16cm (9"x 6½") STAMPED ADDRESSED ENVELOPE.**
- 7. For EACH CLASS, WIs will be supplied with a jeweller's tag with their allocated number. The tags must be sewn, stuck or fixed (no pins) securely to all items. Any items used as accessories must also be marked with the WI number**
- 8. All items must be the property and unaided work of the exhibitors, and made within the last 12 months.**
- 9. If your WI enters multiple entries for a class, they will be labelled with your WI number and letter a, b etc.**
- 10. In the event that a WI has to cancel any of their entries they must notify the show designer. It is regretted that Entry Fees cannot be refunded.**
