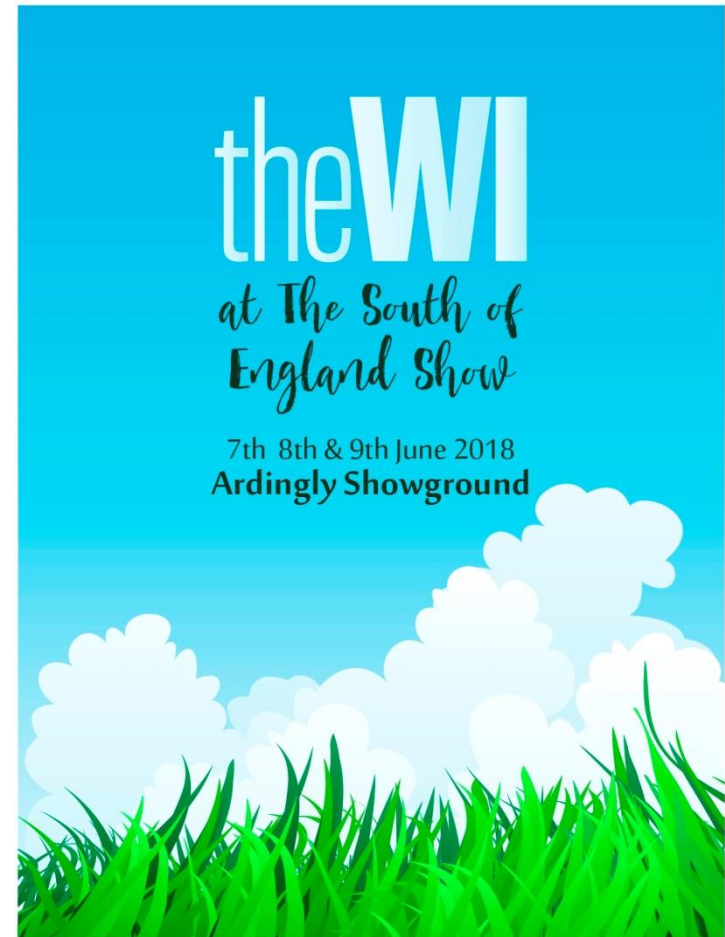

**CLASSES 1 – 8 ARE JUDGED IN ADVANCE**

**Class 1 – THROUGH THE KEYHOLE**

A fabric wall hanging. Any size, not knitting or crochet. Embellishments may be used. Ready to hang using a piece of dowel that extends beyond the edge by 5cm each side. Please roll up and wrap securely with class and WI number on outside.

**Class 2 – WHODUNNIT?**

A story in no more than 120 words (excluding the title), suitably illustrated. To be presented in large print on one side of a laminated A4 sheet of card. Some marks for presentation will be included. Two members may take part.

**Class 3 – VISION OF SUMMER**

A watercolour painting. To be mounted and framed with 2 rings (with hole at least 5mm diameter) at the side for hanging. Maximum size with frame 50cm x 50cm (need not be square). Please pack in a padded envelope with WI number and class number written on the outside.

**Class 4 –THE SHIRT OFF YOUR BACK**

An item made from two recycled shirts. No extra fabric to be used. Interfacing, stuffing and embellishments allowed. Please enclose an A5 laminated picture of original shirts.

All entries should be **INDIVIDUALLY** packaged with WI and Class number written on the outside. Packaging will not be returned.

**All entries must be collected from the Showground after 6.15pm on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> June 2018.**

**Classes 9 - 13** must be brought to the showground on **Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> June 2018 between 8am and 9.30am.** Only two members per WI will be allowed into the marquee for set up. Please book in at the table on arrival and a member of the committee will show you where to place your entries. Allotted set-up time is 30 minutes. All packaging must be removed. Please leave the marquee as soon as your exhibit is complete. The marquee will be closed at 10am. Your entries will be moved after judging.

All craft items must be the property and unaided work of the exhibitors. They must have been made within the last 12 months.

No kits or miniatures to be used in craft or cookery.

The WI will not accept any responsibility for the loss or damage to property at any time.

**Removal** **No exhibit or mark cards may be removed before 6.15pm on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> June 2018.**

No cars are admitted onto the Showground until after 7pm. The Committee will not accept responsibility for any items not collected by 8pm.

## **RULES AND INSTRUCTIONS**

All exhibitors must be WI Members.

The closing date for entry forms is **Friday 30th March 2018**. WIs must enclose two C5 (23cm x 16 cm, 9" x 6½") stamped addressed envelopes with their form and a cheque made out to East Sussex Federation (ESFWI).

Please ensure all participating members receive a copy of this schedule and rules. Marks will be deducted if exhibits do not conform to the schedule. The Judges' decision is final. Refer to 'On With The Show' (OWTS) 2015 Handbook for the definitions of the various classes. This is available on the Moodle at [www.witraining.org.uk](http://www.witraining.org.uk).

**Labelling Entries:** Each WI will be allocated numbered tags by the end of April. Every item in each class must be labelled with this number. Tags must be securely fixed without the use of pins. Accessories must be marked with WI number. No other identifying marks or names to be used.

In the event that a WI has to cancel an entry, they must notify the Show Committee. It is regretted that entry fees cannot be refunded.

**Classes 1 - 8** are to be judged in advance, these classes must be delivered to either of the County Offices, or by arrangement to a committee member, by **Thursday 17th May 2018**.

### **Class 5 – BABY LOVE**

An item as a gift for a baby, any medium. Not a cookery item.

### **Class 6 – YARN BUSTER**

A knitted item using a minimum of four colours, any size. Lining, stuffing and embellishments allowed. Please enclose photocopy of pattern if used, with details of yarn type and any adaptations.

### **Class 7 – FAIR AND SQUARE**

A crocheted item made from squares. Lining, stuffing and embellishments allowed. Please enclose photocopy of pattern if used, with details of yarn type and any adaptations.

See p65 OWTS 2015.

### **Class 8 – TOOLS OF THE TRADE**

A handmade container in any medium. Please include photos taken during production. If contents are included, please ensure that all items are attached for security reasons.

Maximum size 60cm in any dimension.

### **Class 9 – BITS AND PIECES**

An item featuring mosaic made using resistant materials, e.g. stone, glass and ceramic. Maximum size 60cm in any dimension.

### **Class 10 – ORANGES ARE NOT THE ONLY FRUIT**

An un-iced, undecorated citrus drizzle cake. Any shape or size, presented on a cake board. Please include the FULL recipe on an A5 laminated card for display.

### **Class 11 - KALEIDOSCOPE**

An exhibit of colourful fresh plant material displayed on a board. Accessories allowed. Space allowed 50cm x 50 cm, height unrestricted. Please be aware that entry will be moved after judging.

### **Class 12 – THE TOY SHOP (semi co-operative)**

A knitted and/or crocheted scene staged on a board. No accessories but embellishments allowed.

Any support materials must be covered by knitting or crochet. Space allowed 50cm x 50cm.

A minimum of two members to take part.

### **Class 13 – READERS' CHOICE (co-operative)**

A co-operative class based on a book of your choice.

In addition to the four items listed a) to d) below, please include an A5 laminated card with a photo or picture of the front cover for display.

(This card does not have to be displayed on the board and can be outside the space allowed).

- a) A bookmark in a protective cover
- b) An additional craft item inspired by your book.
- c) Five sweet biscuits made from the same mixture, displayed on a plate and covered with cling film. Judged as a cookery item.

- d) An exhibit of natural plant material

All four items to be staged on a board and marked with WI number.

Space allowed 50cm x 50cm height unrestricted.

Accessories allowed.

Minimum of 3 members to take part.

Your entry will be judged for staging and interpretation ahead of the four items which are judged individually.

Please enclose a diagram or photo of your entry as items will be moved during judging. For judges' information only, please include a full list of ingredients for the biscuits.
