9. All Classes should be brought to the Showground on **Friday 4th October 2019 and staged between 9.30am and 10.30am**. Only two members per WI will be allowed into the room to avoid congestion. The room will be closed at 10.30am. **Classes 5,6,7,8 and 10 can be delivered to either of the Federation offices from 24th - 26th September**. Check opening hours before travelling and pack items individually with WI class and number on the outside. If your item needs to be returned to the Federation offices, please contact Judy Street.
10. Although the greatest care will be taken, the WI cannot accept responsibility for the loss or damage to property at any time. **Please do not use valuable items.**

Class 1 CLEAR CUT

A jar of fruit jelly. Approximate size 225g.

Class 2 GET SHORTY

Five identical pieces of shortbread, made from one mixture and displayed on a plate. Please provide a list of ingredients on A5 card.
See p116 OWTS 2015.

Class 3 SAY CHEESE

Five identical cheese straws, made from one mixture and presented on a plate. Please include full recipe on A5 card.
See p118 OWTS 2015.

Class 4 COMMITTEE'S CHOICE

Coffee and Walnut Cake. A quarter of the cake, presented on a plate and covered. Please include full recipe on A5 card. See p107-109 OWTS 2015.

Class 5 'O CHRISTMAS TREE'

A hand made tree decoration, any craft, with provision for hanging.
Maximum size 10cm, excluding hanger.

Class 6 WINTER WARMER

A hand knitted/crocheted decorative hot water bottle cover, any size. Must include hot water bottle/ rechargeable pad. Please include yarn band and pattern, if used. See p65 and p78 OWTS 2015.

Class 7 BROACH THE SUBJECT

A brooch, any medium. See OWTS 2015 for specific crafts.

Class 8 MARK THE OCCASION

A hand crafted card, any size, no envelope required. See p76 OWTS 2015.

Class 9 NATURE'S BOUNTY

An exhibit of natural and/or artificial plant material incorporating fruit and vegetables. Accessories allowed. Displayed on a board 60cm x 60cm.

Class 10 YOUR BEST SHOT

An unmounted photograph taken in the last 12 months, size 7"x5" or 8"x6". Please note that Velcro will be attached to the back for display.
See p102-103 OWTS 2015.

- 4. All exhibitors must be WI Members. All items must be the property and unaided work of the exhibitors, and made within the last 12 months.**
- 5. Closing date for entry forms Friday 20th September 2019.**
- 6. All WIs who enter must enclose one C5 23cm x 16cm (9"x 6½") stamped addressed envelope.**
- 7. For each class, WIs will be supplied with a jeweller's tag for each class with their allocated number. The tags must be sewn, stuck or fixed (no pins) securely to all items. Any items used as accessories must also be marked with the WI number.**
